

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

By this agreement, made as of 30 January 2023 between the Naval Supply Systems Command (Weapon Systems Support): NAVSUP WSS, hereinafter called "the Lender" and Naval Base Coronado/Naval Air Station North Island (NBC/NASNI) hereinafter called "the Recipient," the Lender hereby for an initial period often (10) years, renewable, loans to the Recipient the following United States Government property:

The Recipient agrees to the following terms and conditions:

1. To ensure that the loaned aircraft for display or educational purposes only and to protect the aircraft as far as possible in order to deter unauthorized access;
2. To ensure that the NBC/NASNI fulfills its responsibility for maintaining the aircraft in good material condition including corrosion control, painting, preservation, etc. and not to cannibalize, exchange, or remove parts of the aircraft or to modify the aircraft without written permission by the Lender;
3. If, at any time, the loaned aircraft is no longer needed for display or if the Recipient no longer wishes to keep the aircraft, written notice shall be given to the Lender. The Lender will:

a. Advise the Recipient that the Lender of other requirements for the loaned aircraft and will make appropriate arrangements for repositioning;

b. Advise the Recipient that the Lender desires to repossess the aircraft and will arrange for appropriate disposition at the present location.

c. Advise that the Lender has no further requirement for the aircraft and that the Recipient, at the Recipient's expense, is authorized, based on the Recipient's preference, to dispose of the aircraft as follows:

Demilitarize/destroy the property to the extent required by current Department of Defense policy as set forth by detailed guidance to be provided by the Lender. The Recipient will be required to certify in writing to the Lender that all requirements have been met and will provide the Lender with photographs depicting the specific demilitarization and/or destruction accomplished.

Executed on behalf of the Lender 30 January 2023 at Philadelphia, PA, United States of America.

4. This agreement does not obligate any further support from the installation for the movement of the aircraft for storage and display.
